## PART-TIME LIBRARY EMPLOYEE HIRING PROCESS

<u>Step 1</u> - All employees under age 16 must obtain a work permit.

Documentation needed for work permit:

- 1. Proof of age Certified copy of birth certificate or baptismal record.
- 2. Letter from the City stating the intent to employ the minor along with the job duties, hours of work, and time of day the minor will be working.
- 3. Letter from the minor's parent, guardian, or court-ordered foster parent while the minor is under their care and supervision consenting to the employment. As an alternative, the parent, guardian, or foster parent may countersign the employer's letter.
- 4. The minor's Social Security card.
- 5. \$10.00 statutory permit fee. (Bring receipt to Pam at City Hall for reimbursement when you come to fill out hiring paperwork. See Step 2.)
- 6. School address or school district the minor attends.
- 7. Minor must appear to sign the work permit.

Step 2 - Hiring Paperwork (Personal information, tax withholding forms, Form I-9, policies)

Documentation needed for hiring paperwork:

- A. Social Security card, U.S. passport, or birth certificate (original or certified copy)
- B. Driver's license, ID Card issued by Federal or State Government with photo, school ID with photo, or U.S. military card.

For persons under age 18 who are unable to present a document listed in Item B:

- School record or report card
- Clinic, doctor, or hospital record
- C. Voided check or deposit slip from bank account you want your pay to be deposited to. If you do not have a bank account, you must set one up. If you do not have a voided check or deposit slip that is <u>pre-printed</u> with bank routing number and your account number, please have the bank type a letter on bank letterhead stating you have an account, type of account, bank routing number, and your account number.
