	Read a lift-the-flap book and talk about what you find under the flaps. On the line write down your favorite under-the-flap find.
	Have fun blowing bubbles together. Count how many you can pop. Talk about the shape of the bubbles.
	Write a review on a book you recently read to your child. You may email your review to juneau@monarchlibraries.org or bring a handwritten review to the library. On the line write the date you submitted your review.
	Pick a letter and say as many words as you can that begin with that letter. On the line write the letter you picked
	Sing the "Itsy Bitsy Spider" and do the actions that go along with the song.
	Play music and dance. Stop the music and have your child freeze in place.
	Build a sandcastle out of blocks or sand. Have fun knocking it down when you are done building it!

	Find something blue, yellow and red. Did you know these are primary colors? Listen to a YouTube song about colors or make up one of your own.	
	Talk about opposites together (examples: up/down, big/little, hot/cold).	
	Point to the words and pictures you see while reading a story. On the line write the title of the book you shared together.	
you spe	Teach your baby or toddler the sign language motions for "dragon." Put your hands arched/cupped upwards in front of your mouth. Then wiggle your fingers and pull them out in front of you like the flames of a dragon. Use the sign in a sentence (or several) with your child.
